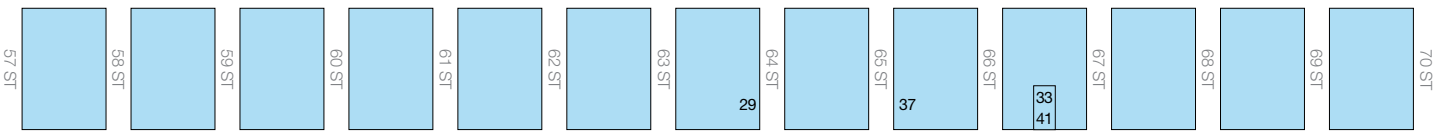


Funds raised by the Madison Avenue Gallery Walk will benefit The Fund for Public Schools to support arts education in New York City public schools.

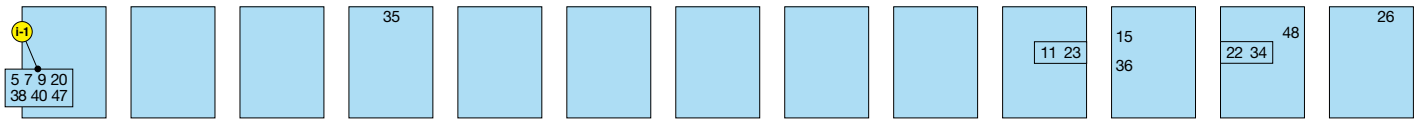

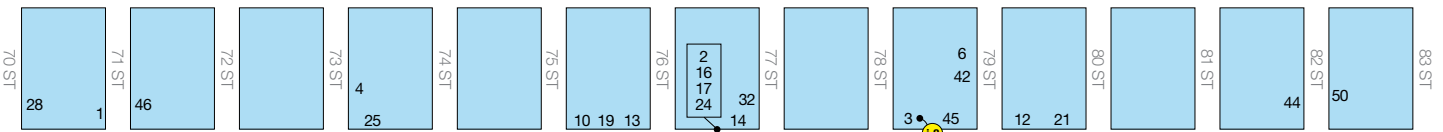

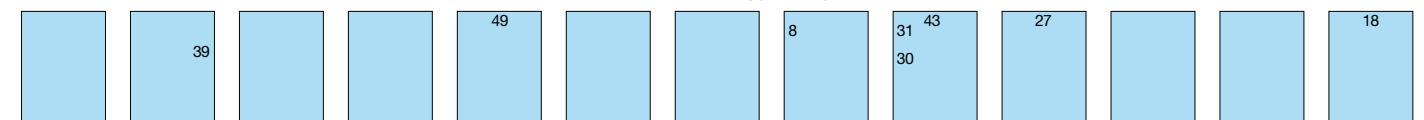
